- **Additional Remarks:** On Monday, April 4 at approximately 8:00 p.m. a call was made to 9-1-1 from a woman who said she'd been robbed while leaving her job at Virginia Business Systems. The woman told police that she was approached by a man who brandished a knife and asked her for money. She told police that as she was reaching into her vehicle to retrieve her wallet the man cut her across the top of her hand with the knife. The man then grabbed the wallet and fled on foot. The suspect is described as a white male standing over six feet in height. He had a hood over his head and was wearing sunglasses. The jacket/sweatshirt the man was wearing is distinctive. It is an Under Armour brand hoodie. The hoodie was black with a white logo on the front of the jacket. The cut to the woman's hand bled but did not require stitches.
