Police have new information regarding the search for 66-year-old Freddie Fralin - a missing Roanoke County man with dementia. Police believe he may now be in the Vinton area.

Fralin was last seen leaving the Kentucky Fried Chicken restaurant on Electric Road near Tanglewood Mall shortly before noon yesterday (Wed., March 28). With the public's help, police have determined that shortly after leaving the restaurant Fralin boarded a Valley Metro bus in the vicinity of the mall. He then exited the bus at the First Citizens Bank on Hardy Road in Vinton around 12:45 p.m. Police have now shifted the focus of their search to this area.

Fralin was last seen wearing a navy blue t-shirt with Reston South in white lettering on the front, dark colored pants, black shoes, and a dark colored baseball cap.

Fralin is an elderly black male, who is balding with salt and pepper hair, approximately 6'0" tall, 180 pounds, and has a thick mustache.
