The Roanoke County Electoral Board met at 12 noon on Tuesday, November 21, 2017. The meeting was called to order at 12:05 pm with all members present as well as the General Registrar. The Board met to evaluate observations made at the polling places on Election Day, Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

After discussion of facilities, logistics of the polling locations, Election Day feedback, and in recognition of the Codified preference for putting polling places in public buildings, the Board requested that the Registrar begin to investigate the potential relocation of polling places in several precincts in which there are publicly-owned alternative sites.

After further discussion, and pending availability of options and assessment of their suitability in terms of precinct size, facility space, ADA accessibility, and other legal requirements for polling locations prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth and U.S. government, Mr. Adkins moved that the board pursue relocation of Precinct 106 – Green Hill to the new Glenvar Public Library and Precinct 201 – Plantation as well. Mr. Martin seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:45 pm.
