Ideas We Heard from the Community So Far:

Construct bicycle lanes and ADA-accessible infrastructure, including crosswalks, sidewalks and greenways	Improve intersections along Route 419 to facilitate traffic flow through the area
Expand park and recreation opportunities, including Oak Grove Park, with public trails and activity spaces for kids	Upgrade commercial buildings and facades
	Add restaurants, cafes, retail, grocery shopping and public spaces for people to hang out

Study Area Facts

- 173 total acres in the study
- Great visibility: 26,000 vehicles/day on Rt. 419
- More than 80 commercial and residential properties
- Investment opportunities: vacant and undeveloped sites
