Roanoke County is planning to construct an additional segment of the Roanoke River Greenway. A Public Review Period is open to receive comments on its plans to construct an approximately 1.4-mile section of the Roanoke River Greenway from Rutrough Point at the terminus of Rutrough Road, through property owned by the Virginia Recreational Facilities Authority and leased by Roanoke County (known as Explore Park) to the northern edge of Explore Park to connect with another segment of the Roanoke River Greenway planned for construction in 2023. The greenway through Explore Park is proposed to be ten feet wide and paved. Please see the enclosed legal notice and project location maps for further details.

In accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), Roanoke County has conducted environmental investigations necessary to evaluate impacts of the proposed greenway on cultural resources, agricultural/open space, farmland, invasive species, air quality, noise, threatened and endangered species, hazardous materials, water quality, and environmental justice. Compliance with state and federal environmental laws and regulations is summarized in the form of a Categorical Exclusion. 

