


### Reduce Starkey Road Lane Width - Add Shared Use Path



### Reason Concept Not Selected:

- 1) Significant impacts on adjacent parcels
- 2) Relocating curbing and reconstructing the roadway is cost prohibitive

### Reduce Starkey Road Lane Width - Add Cycle Track



### Reason Concept Not Selected:

- 1) Narrowing Starkey Road lanes to 10' not desirable
- 2) Bicycle transition through the Starkey Road/Ogden Road intersection may be challenging and uncomfortable
