Please join Roanoke County Staff and our consultants, Whitman, Requardt & Associates, LLP, at a Design Public Hearing/Open House to review and comment on the Plantation Road Bicycle, Pedestrian and Streetscape Improvement Project plans at **Country Inn & Suites, 7860 Plantation Road, on Thursday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2014, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.** There will be no formal presentation so you may come and go when you please.

Roanoke County and our consultants continue to work on plans to improve Plantation Road between Interstate 81 and Williamson Road. Comments received from the January 2014 Citizen Information Meeting, recent discussions with Plantation Road businesses and others have been incorporated into plans for Phase One of the Plantation Road Project.

Phase One is designed to include:

- Pedestrian and bicycle shared use path on the west side of Plantation Road from Williamson Road to Walrond Drive;
- Sidewalk on the west side of Plantation Road from Walrond Drive to Gander Way;
- Sidewalk on the east side of Plantation Road from Williamson Road to Friendship Lane;
- Street trees, pedestrian lighting, crosswalks and pedestrian signals; and
- Curb, gutter, and storm drains.

Project plans may also be reviewed at the Roanoke County Administration Center located at 5204 Bernard Drive, Roanoke, VA 24018. Give your written or oral comments at the meeting or submit them by **December 1, 2014**, to David Holladay, Planning Administrator, P.O.
